

Linedraw Symbols

The following symbols will cover most, if not all, situations that arise when mapping passages. It is best to use these symbols in a slightly smaller font than the text font. The text font of this handout is 12 point, and the symbols are 10 point.

When I begin a map, I open this document, copy and paste the symbols to the document with the map I am working on, and then copy and paste the ones I need as I do the flow. The first and last symbols are each made of three separate symbols $\Gamma - \perp$ and $\perp - \Gamma$. In order to lengthen the line, copy the middle symbol ($-$) and then paste it repeatedly to form the length of line needed. In actual practice, I usually only need the first three symbols ($\Gamma \perp \Gamma$).

When I use a font other than Times New Roman for a Greek map, I need to be sure these symbols are in Times New Roman since they do not work correctly in all fonts.
