| 5:12–16 | Apostles perform many wonders | Jerusalem |
| 8:14–17 | Peter and John communicate the Holy Spirit | Samaria |
| 9:1–9 | Paul converted | Road to Damascus |
| 9:33–34 | Peter heals Eneas of a palsy | Lydda |
| 9:36–41 | Peter raises Tabitha, or Dorcas, to life | Joppa |
| 12:7–17 | Peter delivered out of prison by an angel | Jerusalem |
| 12:21–23 | God smites Herod, so that he dies | Jerusalem |
| 13:6–11 | Elymas, the sorcerer, smitten with blindness | Paphos |
| 14:8–10 | Paul heals a cripple | Lystra |
| 16:16–18 | Paul casts out a spirit of divination | Philippi |
| 16:25–26 | Paul and Silas's prison doors opened by an earthquake | Philippi |
| 19:1–6 | Paul communicates the Holy Spirit | Corinth |
| 19:11–12 | Paul heals multitudes | Corinth |
| 20:9–12 | Paul restores Eutychus to life | Troas |
| 28:3–6 | Paul shakes off a viper | Malta |
| 28:7–9 | Paul heals the father of Publius and others | Malta |
